This Privacy Notice is published by AXA NEXT, located at 61 rue Mstislav Rostropovich, 75018 Paris. The respect of your privacy is a priority for AXA Next. As a user of this website, this Privacy Notice aims to present the content of the personal data processed by AXA Next on its website.

The present processing of personal data is governed by:

- By the French law n°78-17 of January 6th, 1978, "loi Informatique et libertés" (hereinafter "LIL");
- By Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016, entered into force on 25 May 2018 (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR").

Our commitments

Acting as a data controller, AXA Next respects the following principles:

- your data is used only for explicit, legitimate and determined purposes related to Axa Next's core business (innovation);
- only the data that is useful to us are collected;
- We do not store your data beyond the time required for the purpose for which they were collected or as required by law;
- we do not share your data outside of the authorized service providers or members of AXA Next, who need to know about it in the course of their activities;
- we inform you, in a clear and transparent manner, when you authenticate on the site, of the optional or mandatory nature of your answers in the forms and of your rights in terms of data protection;
- Any new information about the processing of your data will be updated in this Notice.

Our use of your personal data and recipients

Your data is only used for the following purposes:

This data is only accessible by the authorized AXA Next staff in charge of the Innovation Program and by the subcontractors in charge to collect candidates' information, to host and maintain the website.

Their provision is not mandatory. However, if you refuse to provide this information to AXA Next, you may not be able to fully use the website.

Security

Confidentiality measures

AXA Next and its subcontractors undertake to implement all technical and organizational measures to ensure the security of your personal data processing and the confidentiality of your data.

To that end, AXA Next takes the necessary precautions, regarding the nature of your data and the risks presented by the processing, to preserve the security of your data and, in particular, to prevent them from unauthorised or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction or damage.

Binding Corporate Rules (BCR)

We are the first insurance Group to have internal company rules approved by 16 European personal Data Protection Authorities (DPA), including the CNIL. These rules guarantee a level of intangible and minimum protection of your data by the various companies of the AXA Group worldwide.

Data transfer control

This processing does not imply the transfer of personal data outside the European Economic Area (EEA). In the event of a significant change or evolution in the processing and to the extent that such non-EEA processing should take place, AXA Next undertakes to inform you and to implement appropriate protective measures, according to article 46 of the GDPR.

Your rights as a data subject

As a data subject, you are entitled to exercise the following rights:

- to access your data,
- to ask for their correction in the event of an error,
- to ask for their erasure,
- to request the limitation of the processing of your data,
- to ask for their portability,
- to oppose to the processing of your data when the processing is based on your consent,
- to set guidelines for their fate after your death.
